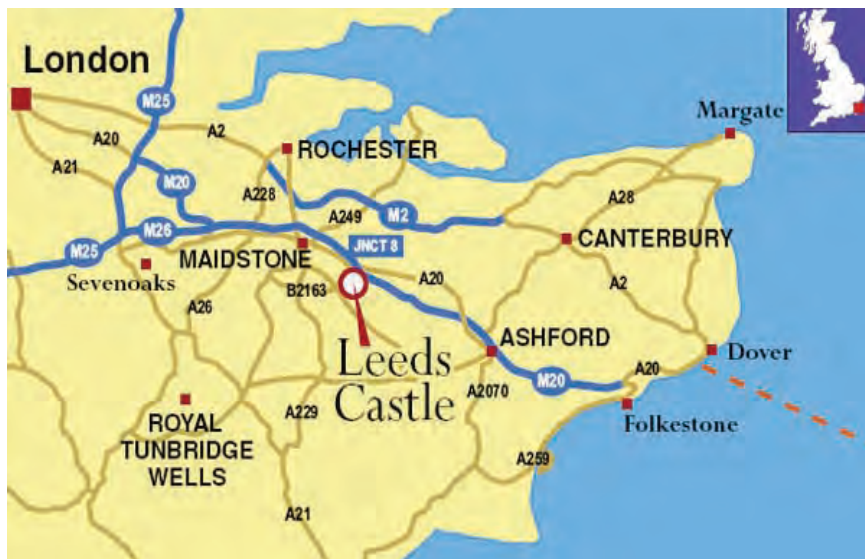


Travelling by car

The castle can be found 7 miles east of Maidstone, Junction 8 of the M20 motorway. The castle is clearly sign posted from all routes with the brown tourist signs; however you will see additional signs provided by the AA in yellow. The main castle entrance is Penfold Hill, just off the Ashford Road (A20).
